CANOE / KAYAK SAFETY TIPS, REQUIREMENTS & WAIVER OF LIABILITY

- All watercraft occupants must wear a Coast Guard Approved Personal Flotation Device (PFD)
- Paddlers under 18 must be with or supervised by an adult
- Be aware of the river current – canoeists should not travel in the river channel if the current exceeds the safe level for your ability (Do not over estimate your paddling ability)
- Stay sober. Drugs or alcohol can seriously impair your paddling ability
- Kneel down in the canoe for better stability
- Do not exceed the watercraft weight or occupant capacity
- Be aware of your time – additional charges will accrue if rental equipment not returned on time

Wisconsin Law Provides:

- A participant in a recreational activity accepts the risk inherent in the activity of which the ordinary prudent person is or should be aware.
- A participant in a recreational activity is responsible to act within the limits of his or her ability, to heed all warnings regarding participation in the recreational activity, to maintain control of his or her person and equipment, devices or animals the person is using while participating in the recreational activity, to refrain from acting in any manner that may cause or contribute to injury to himself or herself or to other persons while participating in the recreational activity.

Waiver of Liability: Canoeing and kayaking can be a dangerous activity especially on a river. Rivers can run very high and deep, especially at certain times of the year and after heavy rains. Obstacles including log jams and fallen or overhanging trees are common along the river and can cause a canoe or kayak to overturn, creating a risk of injury or drowning. The undersigned hereby acknowledges and accepts these and other unnamed risks and agrees to hold Dodge County and its employees or agents free of all liability for this activity. The undersigned also assumes all inherent risks for all participants of this activity in his/her group and assumes the responsibility to make his/her own assessment of the safety of the river conditions based upon the age and experience of the people in his/her group.

I have read and understand the above safety tips, requirements and waiver of liability and agree to abide by them and return all rental equipment by the specified time and in the same condition as rented (normal wear and tear exempted). I agree to pay all costs associated with any lost or damaged equipment rented by me.
