

WILD GOOSE PARK - CITY OF JUNEAU

Situated along the Wild Goose Recreation Trail, the park and its campsites will serve bikers and hikers who seek rest and restrooms, as well as encourage camping and other use by residents and non-residents.

The park features a shelter with toilets, coin-operated showers and picnic tables.

Located on the city's northeast side, the Wild Goose Park is the only Juneau park in which camping is allowed. No one may be in a Wild Goose Park camping area after 11 p.m., unless they have completed a self-registration form available at the park shelter. Payment of the \$10 fee also will be self-regulated, although Juneau Police plan to patrol and enforce all laws.

No glass containers are allowed in the park and anyone under 18 will not be allowed in campsites unless accompanied by a parent or other responsible adult.
